
All modern operating systems, including Windows and iOS, and browsers, including Chrome, Edge, Safari, and Firefox, are supported.

Type of Application:

New: Request for support of a project that has not yet been funded.

Renewal: Request for additional funding for a period of subsequent to that provided by a current award. Renewal applications compete for funding with all other peer reviewed applications and must be developed as fully as though the applicant is applying for the first time. (Previously referred to as "Competing Continuation")

Revision (Supplement): A revision is a request for (or the award of) additional funds during a current project period to support new or additional activities that are not identified in the current award. This request reflects an expansion of the scope of the approved activities. An administrative supplement is a request for (or the award of) funds during a current project period for an increase in costs due to unforeseen circumstances. All additional costs must be within the scope of the peer reviewed and approved project.

Resubmission: An unfunded application that has been modified following initial review and resubmitted for new consideration.
